1. What is the Virtual BAYOU Summer Program?

The **Virtual Beginning Agricultural Youth Opportunities Unlimited (BAYOU) Program** provides an opportunity for high school students to gain "first hand" knowledge about career opportunities in Agriculture, Family and Consumer Sciences and related disciplines.

2. What is the purpose of the College of Agricultural Family and Consumer Sciences Program?

The major purpose of this program is to stimulate interest in careers opportunities available in the agricultural fields of study among high school students.

3. Who is eligible to participate?

Rising high school seniors (have completed 11th grade) and graduating seniors (incoming freshman)

4. What are the academic requirements?

Minimum GPA of 2.5

5. How will the program be delivered?

The program will be delivered virtually as we continue to fight our way through the COVID-19 Pandemic. Selected students will be **required** to be online from 9am to 12pm each day for the duration of the program.

6. Is there a cost to participate in the program?

No. The program pays all expenses.

Graduating seniors who are interested in agricultural, family and consumer sciences, business or the natural sciences and have an ACT (SAT equivalent) composite score of 20 and above, or High School GPA of 2.5 or greater, or rank top 50% of high school graduation class AND require no more than ONE remedial course.
